Studio projects will include painting, drawing and design and will be directed towards developing a cohesive portfolio. All mediums are invited; painting, drawing, photograph, installation, and video.

Yura Adams holds an MFA and BFA from the San Francisco Art Institute and has teaching experience at IS183, CGCC, and Rhode Island School of Design. She has been the recipient of two National Endowment Grants and is a 2009 New York Foundation for the Arts Mark participant. In 2010, she was awarded the Individual Artist Grant, from New York State Council on the Arts/DEC/Greene County Arts Council. She is represented by John Davis Gallery in Hudson, NY.
